

CHEMICAL MANAGEMENT POLICY

This policy defines our responsible management approach in all processes from the supply of chemical substances to their use, storage to disposal.

All chemical processes are carried out in accordance with national and international legislation, primarily REACH and CLP regulations.

Up-to-date Safety Data Sheets (SDS) are kept for all chemicals.

Chemical management processes and chemical inventory are regularly reviewed by the Chemical Management Team. Action plans are prepared and implemented for identified improvement areas. Chemical risk assessments are carried out at regular intervals.

The use of safer alternatives instead of hazardous chemicals is encouraged (green chemistry approach).

All employees are trained on chemical safety, emergency response and use of personal protective equipment in accordance with their job descriptions.

Chemicals are stored in leak-proof, ventilated, fire-resistant and access-controlled areas appropriate to their classes.

Transportation operations are carried out safely and reliably in accordance with ADR, IMDG-Code and IATA-DGR regulations.

Chemical waste is reduced at source, classified and disposed of or recovered through environmentally licensed companies.

As Aromsa, we are committed to managing all chemicals used during our activities in a way that will not harm the environment, human health and occupational safety throughout their life cycle.

The policies are open and communicated to all relevant parties interacting with Aromsa.
