- Contributing to the fight against climate change, preparing for the international treaties and their implications for Turkey,
- Accordingly, making an inventory of the greenhouse gas every year, reporting it according to the ISO 14064-1 standard,
- Developing projects for production with low-carbon levels, providing trainings to employees regarding climate change and production with low-carbon levels,
- Identifying the corporate risks, opportunities and targets stemming from climate change,
- Monitoring water consumption and use of the resources, setting targets to reduce consumption,
- Executing efficient water and wastewater management based on the protection of ecosystems in order to achieve the set targets,
- Allocating the resources required for water saving, process improvements that will allow for reuse of water and recovery of rain waters,
- Ensuring interaction with all our employees and stakeholders regarding water and climate change in order to raise awareness and making contributions to the efforts aimed at increasing awareness of the local community.
