

SOCIAL COMPLIANCE POLICY

The policy is to comply with the requirements of social responsibility standards; not to discriminate; to comply with the provisions of labour law, to ensure equal work conditions for all employees; not to support child labour; to ensure fair and just remuneration, to ensure a work environment that do not allow ill-treatment, harassing, forced labour and to respect freedom of expression.

Based on the principles that people are the most important asset, the policy is to provide optimum work and social environment, control and inspect suppliers and contractors and ensure optimum employee rights and highest level of relationships between university-industry, to prioritize relationships with NGOs and provide scholarships ; to provide guidance to our suppliers for social responsibility projects; to work in compliance with local and international agreements and ensure continuous improvement.
